The District Attorney's Office of the Eastern Judicial Circuit has openings for Assistant District Attorneys with an interest in high-level drug investigation and prosecution. Candidates who meet the minimum qualifications are welcome to apply.

General Duties include, but are not limited to:

- Evaluating, charging, and prosecuting assigned criminal cases to final conclusion.
- Reviewing reports submitted by law enforcement to determine whether further investigation is needed, approving or returning cases for further investigation, researching alternative charges based upon potential defenses, and developing a trial strategy.

Minimum Qualifications for this Specialty Area: Candidate must be licensed to practice in Georgia or in any other jurisdiction that offers reciprocal admission. The candidate chosen for this assignment will be imbedded with a narcotics enforcement task force. The ideal candidate must possess the ability to work in collaboration with law enforcement as part of Chatham County's Counter Narcotics Team. Candidate should have experience with wire-tap surveillance cases, arrest warrants, RICO investigations, asset forfeiture, drug trafficking, and the sale and/or distribution of dangerous narcotics.
